	The conclusion from reports in 2015 was that the existing	
	air quality management area (AQMA) at Ospringe should	
	be extended up the hill to include the road up to the Mount	
	on the London Road at Ospringe.	
	Swale Borough Council has a statutory duty to monitor air	
BACKGROUND	pollution to protect the health of residents living in Swale.	
	The evidence of diffusion tube monitoring of air pollution	
	from traffic for several years has necessitated the	
	extension of the air quality management area at Ospringe.
