To whom this may concern,
I'm writing with regards to the review of the license for The Ivy Leaf Sheerness by Kent Police.
As a resident of Delamark Road which backs on to the bar I feel that our lives are being seriously affected by the activities from patrons of The Ivy, there is anti social behaviour on a daily basis, throwing glasses all over the carpark which is only cleaned up when residents have asked for it to be cleared, and the amount of rubbish, take away wrappers and food that is just thrown everywhere especially at the weekend, constant use of foul language from the patrons from the time they open at 10 am until the time they close which is anytime from midnight on wards, the patrons never leave quietly and there has been several incidents where whilst under the influence of alcohol the patrons have then got in their vehicles and wrecklessly driven off damaging residents vehicles parked in the carpark and in the street. There have also been occasions where patrons have left the club to urinate in the alley and up against the wall in the car park, they have then returned to the bar. I find it disgusting that during the warmer weather sat in my garden myself and family can smell a really strong smell of cannabis coming from the garden of the bar, it has been mentioned to several authorities including Gordon Henderson and nothing has been done about this at all. I feel the license needs to be seriously looked at as there is no way they should be allowed to get away with what they have been for many years in such a built up residential area especially considering the impact this is having on so many peoples lives.
