B. <u>Emergency Committee</u>

The Council will need to agree amended terms of reference for the Emergency Committee. Its existing terms of reference provides that membership will comprise of Group Leaders on the Council and the Deputy Leader of the Majority Group, or their substitutes.

The proposed terms of reference is as follows: -

Membership to comprise of 6 senior Members, as nominated by their respective Group Leaders. Substitutes will be permitted if agreed by their Group Leader. Leader and Deputy Leader of the Majority Group, or their substitutes, to be Chairman and Vice-Chairman respectively.

C. <u>Other Committees</u>

The Standards Committee cannot be balanced due to its constitution, where Independent Members are required to have 25% of the overall membership of that Committee. This means that currently, the *maximum* number of seats that the Borough Council may appoint is 9.

Similarly, the JTB cannot be overall balanced due to the way the KCC Members are appointed; by division.
