Civil Parking Enforcement services provided by APCOA UK are very closely monitored by the Parking Services team. Services are reviewed against the contact specification at weekly review meetings to examine key performance indicators relating to customer service, pay and display repair performance, and levels of deployed patrol hours for both on street and within pay and display car parks. Levels of parking contravention are also monitored throughout Swale and resources deployed accordingly to improve driver compliance levels. Performance is reviewed at regular meetings with the Cabinet Member and

Options for cashless parking have been explored and a contract specification for this service has been prepared.
