- Maximum Occupancy Limit of 60 Persons.
- Live Music: No more than 4 musicians as per the Operating Schedule.
- Live Music shall not be amplified as per the Operating Schedule.
- CCTV shall be monitored to ensure that it is in good working order.
- All recordings shall be kept for a period of 31 days.
- Access onto the premises shall be given to the police, at any reasonable time, for swabs to be taken for testing on the ION tracer machine.
- There shall be no drink promotions allowing unlimited alcohol for a fixed fee.
- No bottles or containers shall be removed from the premises.
- Any incidents relating to public safety shall be recorded into an incident logbook.
- Adequate signage shall be placed to ensure that customers respect the neighbouring properties.
- Patrols shall be carried out to monitor noise levels emanating from the premises.
- Doors and Windows shall be closed by 23:00hrs daily.
- 'Challenge 21' scheme shall be in operation at the premises, any person(s) who appears under the age of 21 shall be asked to provide photo ID. The only acceptable forms for photo identification shall be a Photo Driving Licence, Passport or a PASS accredited photo card.
- All children are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Children are not permitted on the premises after 19:00hrs, unless attending a pre-booked function.
- All staff shall have the appropriate training in the Licensing Laws, Public Safety and what procedures need to be followed in case of an emergency or incident

Background

Kent Police (Swale Area) have applied for a review of the premises licence of The Kings Arms, High Street, Minster, Sheerness.

The reasons for the request are detailed in the attached review application. In this application the Police have outlined the recent history of the premises and the findings of their recent visits which are mainly crime related in respect of alleged drug offences and trading beyond authorised hours.

This premises currently holds a full Premises Licence, which was issued by Swale Borough Council in January 2008, the application was not referred to committee as there were no objections at the time.

The premises licence is registered to Vintage Taverns Ltd. Mr Terence Burden recently took over the tenancy and the current DPS is Danielle Cheeney who was named on the licence in June 2010.

Consultation

The review application was served by Kent Police on the Fire Brigade, Pollution Team, Planning, Child Protection Services, Weights and Measures, Vintage Taverns and the DPS.

The application was advertised at the Council Offices and on the premises for a period of 28 days, in line with the Governments Hearings Regulations.

One letter in support of the review has been received from a local resident, see attached.

Conclusion

Kent Police have applied for a review of the premises licence. They are requesting that the licence times be restricted and that 7 new conditions replace all of the existing ones as they are out of date. Vintage Taverns (the Licence Holders) have confirmed by e-mail that they fully support these requests but that they are the responsibility of the tenant.

Councillors must decide if any of the following are appropriate:

- *Remove/modify any of the current licensable activities.*
- *Remove/modify any of the licence conditions.*
- *Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor.*
- *Suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months*
- *Revoke the licence*
- *Take no action.*

The premises is a small public house in the village of Minster it has currently opening hours until 0230 in the morning and has had a number of incidents relating to assaults at the premises, allegations of lock ins until the very early hours and intelligence suggesting the mis use of drugs at the premises.

It is clear conditions and a change in the opening hours of the premises are required to establish a firm foundation for the new tenant to comply with the licensing conditions

The premises has a current licence until 0230 which is creating crime and disorder issues and public nuisance issues. It is the believe of the Police that the premises attracts persons from other public houses once the other premises are closed thus the only attraction being is the late closing time. The police are aware that a new tenant has recently arrived however these incidents are since the arrival of the new tenant.

Over the past year the premises has been subject to many allegations of drug use, serious crime and disorder however the basis of the review is that 'lock ins' have been happening with persons leaving in the early hours causing public nuisance to local residents to the extent that the current designated premises supervisor employs SIA staff on a Friday and Saturday.

At this review Police are asking for a change in the opening hours and conditions but will ask that the use of SIA staff is left at the discretion of the premises designated supervisor

The Police ask for the committee to consider the following conditions

Opening hours suggested Sunday until Thursday 12.00 until 24.00 with no alcohol sales after 23.30 hours

Friday and Saturday 12.00 until 01.00 with no admittance after 24.00 hours and no alcohol after 00.30 hours

The following conditions are required to establish strong management of the premises

1. CCTV will be fitted and the system will display on recording the correct time and date of the recording. All records will be clear and of a standard suitable as evidence in court. All areas of the licensed premises will be covered including smoking/garden areas and entrance and exit points.
2. A system will be in place to maintain the quality of the recorded image and a complete audit trail maintained.
3. The CCTV will be maintained so as to be fully operational during the hours the premises are open for licensable activity or persons are in the licensable area and a copy made available to police or responsible authority on request and in any case within 48 hours. The system will be the responsibility of the tenant and designated premises supervisor to ensure it is fully operational at all times the premises are open for licensable activity or persons are in the licensable area.
4. Signage informing customers that CCTV is operational to be clearly displayed.
5. All staff to be trained in their responsibilities under the licensing act 2003 to level 1 BII. This training must be auditable and available to police, local authority licensing officer and trading standards on request.
6. CHALLENGE 25 scheme shall be adopted so that all staff are trained to ask any customer wishing to purchase alcohol, who appears to be under the age of 25 years, for evidence of age. Only ID acceptable will be passport, photo driving licence and any PASS marked identification.
7. Challenge 25 posters to be displayed in all areas of the premises where alcohol is displayed, point of sale and entry.



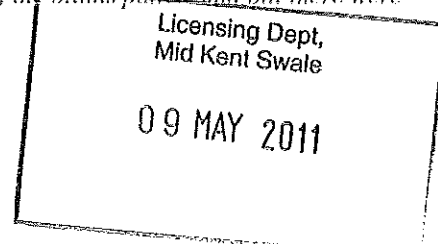
GENESIS

Attended the Kings Arms PH, High Street, Minster for licensing check. They have new landlords in the Burden brothers (not the same as the landowners on the island), claiming they took it over about 3 weeks ago. Daniel BURDEN, 14/05/1979, was on site and was very nervous about our visit and was asking questions about how often we intend to visit and conduct checks.

Inside the pub were around 20 patrons, including Ricky WIGGLESWORTH urn 1368481, Anthony EDGLEY urn 1156044 and Ben SCURFIELD urn 111856. Toilets and bar area checked, nothing untoward. Parked on Chapel Street outside Minster Abbey round the back of the Kings Arms PH was a blue Vauxhall Astra, HY02 NTX, which goes down to Pat SCURFIELD.

On Sunday 1st May we drove past the pub around 01:30 hours and all the lights were on with people inside, blinds open. We drove round the block and back past again a few minutes later intending to enter and all the lights had been turned off and the blinds pulled shut.

On Monday 2nd May I drove past the pub whilst off duty at 03:00 hours and the lights were on, the blinds pulled shut but there were people inside standing at the bar.

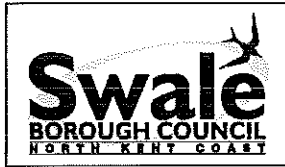

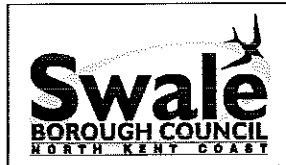

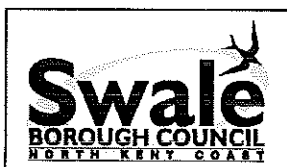

Mandatory Conditions:

- No sale of alcohol can take place where the designated premises supervisor is not a personal licence holder.
- Any door supervisors must be trained and SIA registered.
- (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or

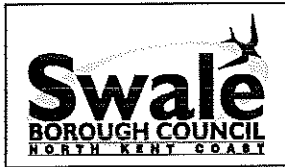
to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

- The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

- The responsible person shall ensure that—
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Note for Entertainment Venues:

The licensee's attention is drawn to the fact that due regard must be paid to the statutory nuisance provisions within the Environmental Protection Act 1990. Compliance with these criteria, the applied licence conditions and the agreed operating schedule does not preclude legal action being taken under the above legislation by either Swale Borough Council or an aggrieved individual.

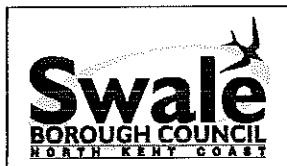

- 'Challenge 21' scheme shall be in operation at the premises, any person(s) who appears under the age of 21 shall be asked to provide photo ID. The only acceptable forms for photo identification shall be a Photo Driving Licence, Passport or a PASS accredited photo card.
- All children are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Children are not permitted on the premises after 19:00hrs, unless attending a pre-booked function.
- All staff shall have the appropriate training in the Licensing Laws, Public Safety and what procedures need to be followed in case of an emergency or incident.

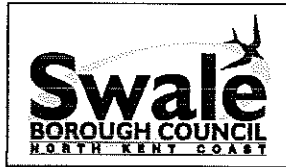

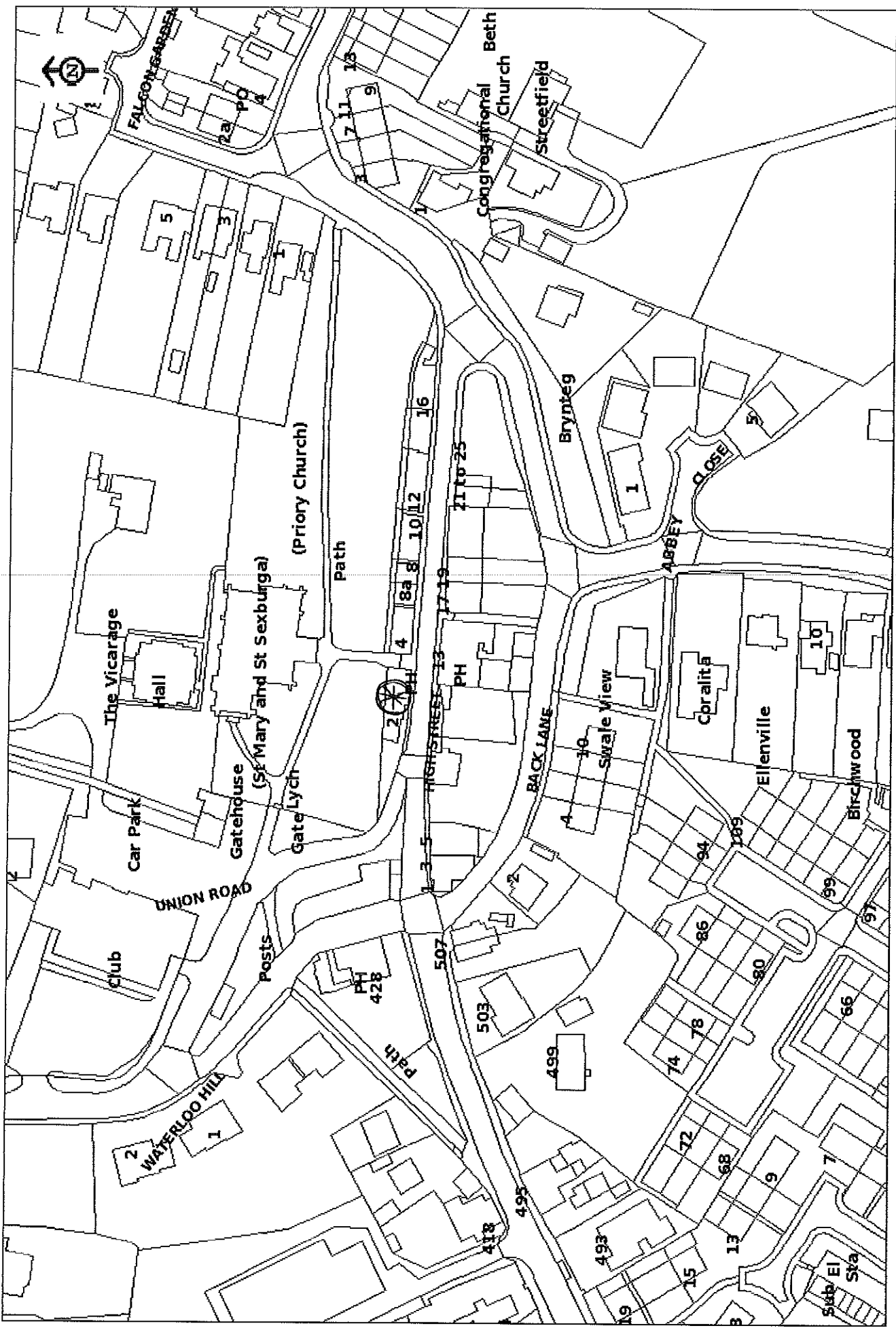
