1 Apologies for Absence

5 South Thames Gateway Building Control Annual Audit and Inspection Letter

6 South Thames Gateway Building Control Business Plan 2012/2017

The Director, South Thames Gateway Building Control Partnership presented the report which set out revised proposals for the South Thames Gateway Building Control Draft Business Plan following consultation and sought agreement of the revisions.

The Chairman confirmed that a discussion paper would be presented to the next meeting setting out options for alternative partnership models.

Discussion ensued regarding whether the partnership's expansion plans would fall within the EU procurement law thresholds, the desire to be entrepreneurial and the importance of understanding the legal implications. It was agreed that further advice would be provided by the Principal Legal Assistant and a draft would be sent to Members in advance of the meeting.

The Chairman referred to the objectives for 2012 - 2017 as set out in the Business Plan, and requested that more emphasis be placed on the marketing and promotion project and that this be started as early as possible.

Decisions:

(1) The Joint Committee approved the updated version of the Business Plan incorporating the comments received and agree to refer it back to the Cabinet of each partner authority to approve the final draft Business Plan.

(2) The Joint Committee noted the final contributions figures which will be included in each authority's budget planning process for 2013/14.

7 Monitoring Report September to November

The Director, South Thames Gateway Building Control Partnership presented the report which updated the Joint Committee on the current forecast for the 2012/13 financial year and gave details against the progress of the objectives of the Business Plan 2011/2014.

The Chairman requested that a report be provided to the next meeting on disabled adaptations. He also thanked officers for their assistance with providing completion certificates for residents at Kemsley Fields, Sittingbourne from the National House Building Council.
