

## Problems with Parked Vehicles Priory Road, Faversham

You may recall that Swale Borough Council sent out leaflets last Autumn with regard to proposals to install double yellow lines in Priory Road, to alleviate the safety hazard caused by parked vehicles in the vicinity of the school access.

The results of this consultation were reported to the Joint Transportation Board, and it was the Board's decision that further consultation should be carried out with the residents to obtain their views on the most favourable solution to the parking problems in Priory Road.


