SUBJECT: THE STREET, OARE - BUS STOP/ON-STREET PARKING

ISSUES

Summary: An update on the Bus Stop/Parking issues in The Street, Oare

Decision Required: That members note the report.

Introduction:

1. At a joint meeting, Oare Parish Council, Swale Borough Council and Kent Highway Services discussed improvements to facilitate better access to buses and prevent footway parking.

Discussion:

- 2. Buses are currently not able to stop parallel with the kerb due to parked vehicles. The lay-by outside Nos.27 33 cannot be used by buses because of parked resident's vehicles.
- 3. It is intended to relocate the bus stop in the lay-by to the northern end outside of the lay-by.
- 4. Some vehicles are not parking fully on the road as it is too narrow without causing obstruction. As a consequence vehicles park partially on the footway and cause obstruction to pedestrians.
- 5. The solution to the problem was for a Traffic Regulation Order to be introduced by Swale Borough Council to prevent parking in the immediate vicinity of the bus stops.
- To supplement the introduction of the parking restrictions, raised bus borders would be constructed to help passengers to board and alight the bus. These would have to be included in a future bid for capital works under the PIPKIN assessment.
- 7. The bus stop locations are shown in appendix 1.
