
These proposals consist of extending the existing parking bay in the vicinity of No.77 Abbey Street, and replacing a section of the existing double yellow line on the south side of Abbey Place with a single yellow line with restricted parking 8:00am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday to match the adjacent single yellow line. The proposals should increase the capacity of parking spaces whilst maintaining safety at the Abbey Place/Abbey Street junction.

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Proposed Parking Restrictions Abbey Road/Abbey Street, Faversham




Following requests from residents during the Faversham Parking Review, Swale Borough Council are proposing to introduce a short section of double yellow line in Abbey Street, Faversham.


These proposals consist of extending the existing parking bay in the vicinity of No.33a Fielding Street, as the vehicle crossing previously at this location is no longer in use.


Swale Borough Council are proposing to install double yellow lines on the junction of Makenade Avenue and Canterbury Road, in Faversham.

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Proposed Parking Restrictions Newton Road, Faversham







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Proposed Parking Restrictions South Road, Faversham


