



## Proposed Amendments to Parking Restrictions Capel Road, Sittingbourne Second Consultation

You may recall we carried out a consultation with residents earlier this year on proposed waiting restrictions to be implemented in Capel Road, Sittingbourne.

The comments received from residents varied greatly, and a total of 5 objections were received to the original proposals. In view of the objections, the Joint Transportation Board recommended that further consultation takes place prior to introducing any restrictions.

Subsequent discussions with various residents of Capel Road highlighted the differing opinions between householders as to the most beneficial layout for waiting restrictions, and it appears that whichever option is consulted upon, we will receive objections from other residents.
