Introduction

1. Following representations from Tunstall Parish Council and a signed petition from residents and the parents of children attending the local Primary School about the need for safety improvements in the Village a meeting was held on 12 December 2007 with KHS officers, local councillors, the Parish Council and key representatives to discuss their concerns in more detail.
2. It was agreed to draw up a scheme which would then be brought back to this group and a meeting was then to be arranged to discuss the proposals in more detail. Please see the attached appendix. This was reported to the Joint Transportation Board on 17 December.

Discussion

3. A further meeting was held on 11 March to talk through the detail of those proposals and an oral up-date of the outcome of that meeting will be given to this Board. The next stage will be to assess this scheme as part of the PIPKIN assessment process and, it is hoped, will then be included within the proposed 2009/10 Integrated Transport programme.
