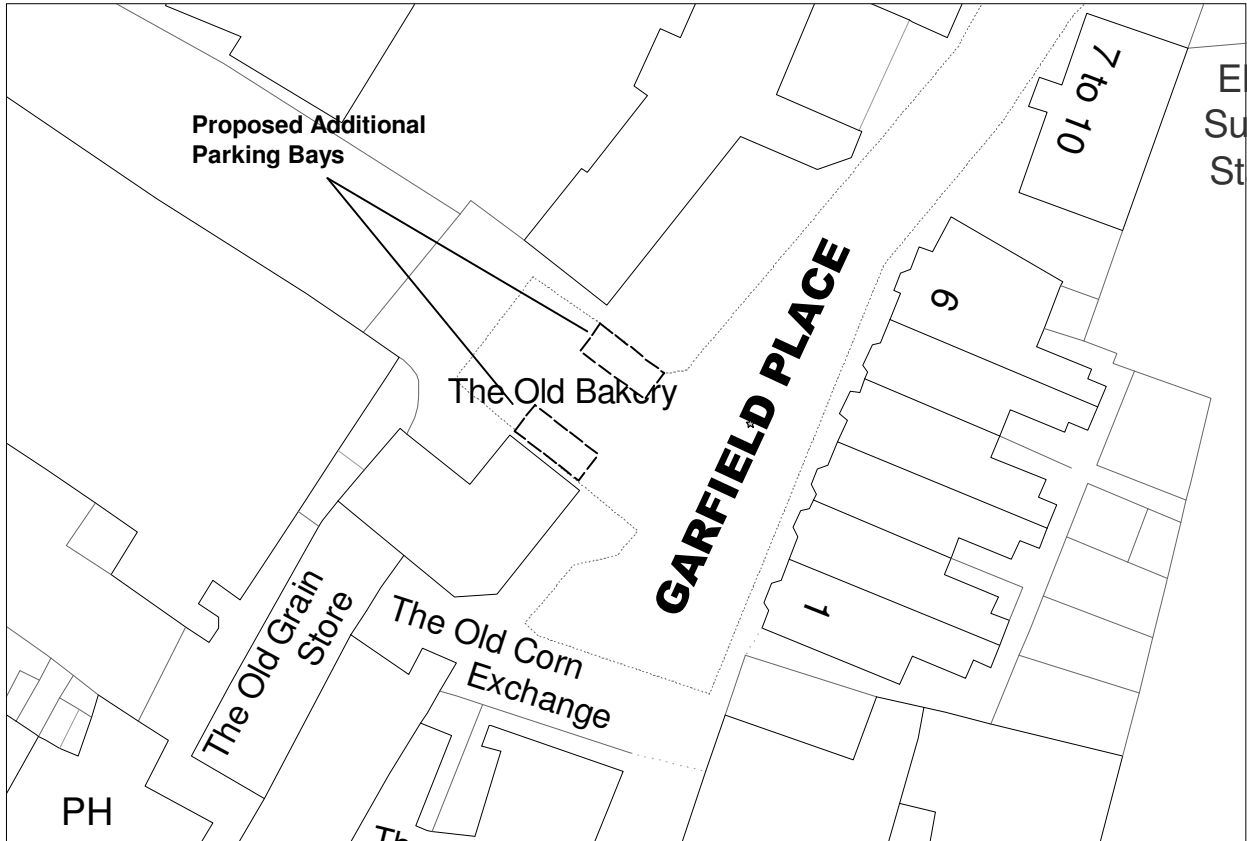

The proposals consist of installing a single yellow line in the vicinity of the entrance to the car park to the rear of Nos.169-175 London Road, to restrict parking between 8:30am – 6:30pm Monday to Saturday. This should improve the safety of vehicles using this car park entrance by increasing visibility on to London Road.

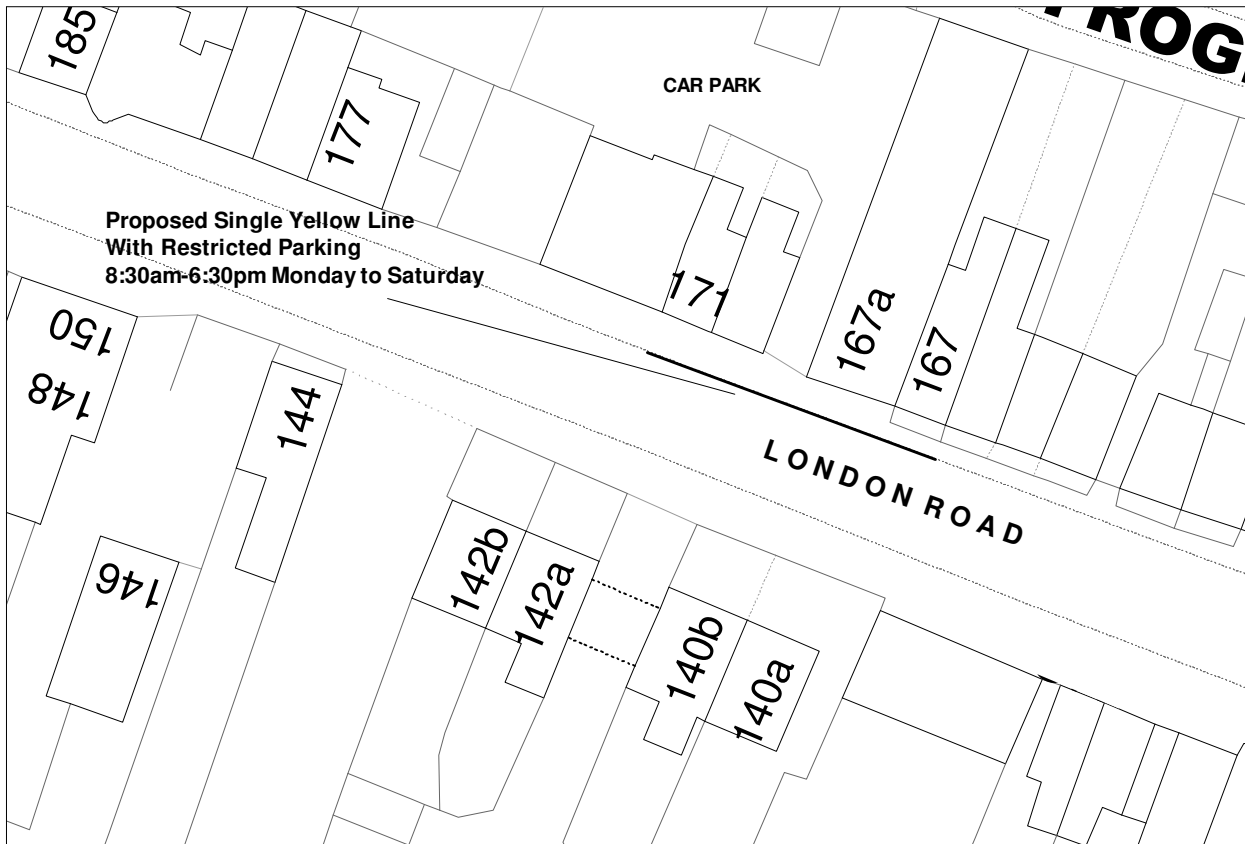

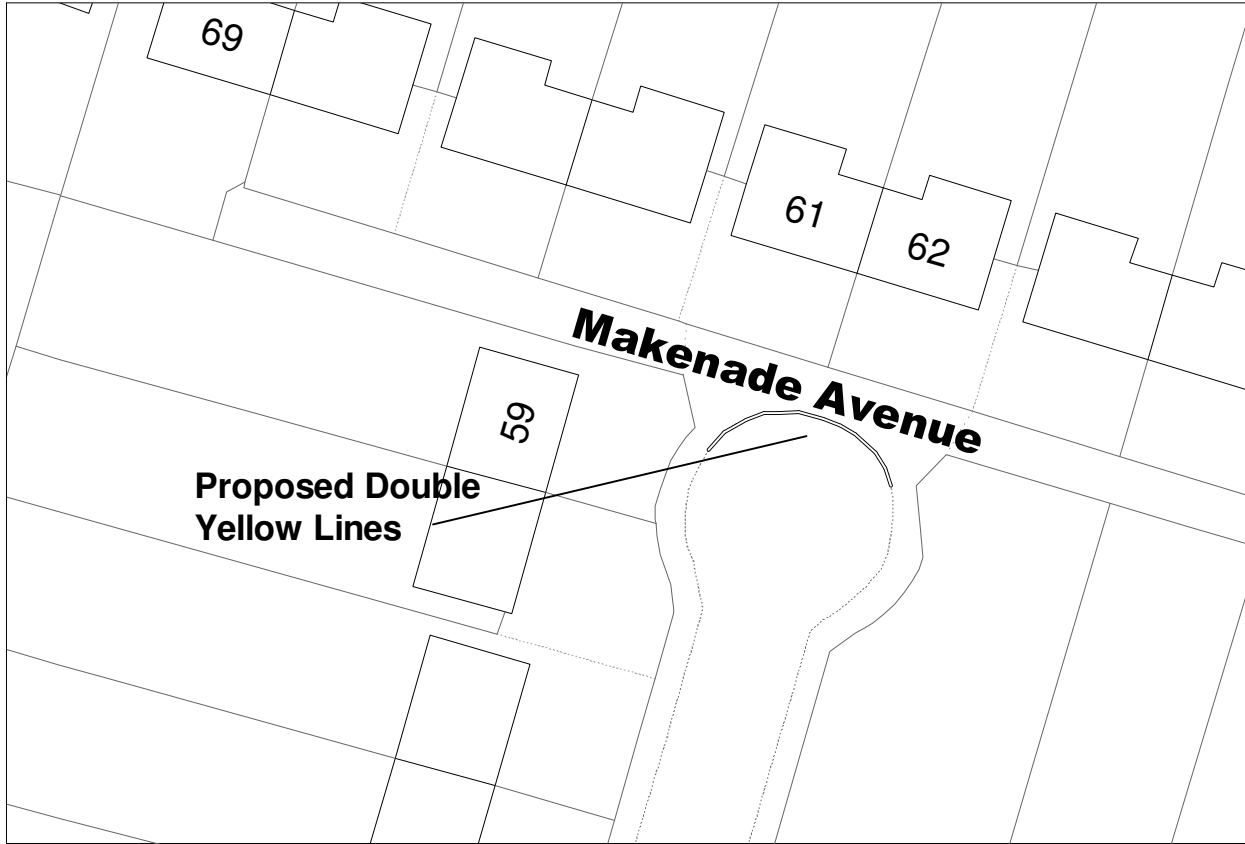

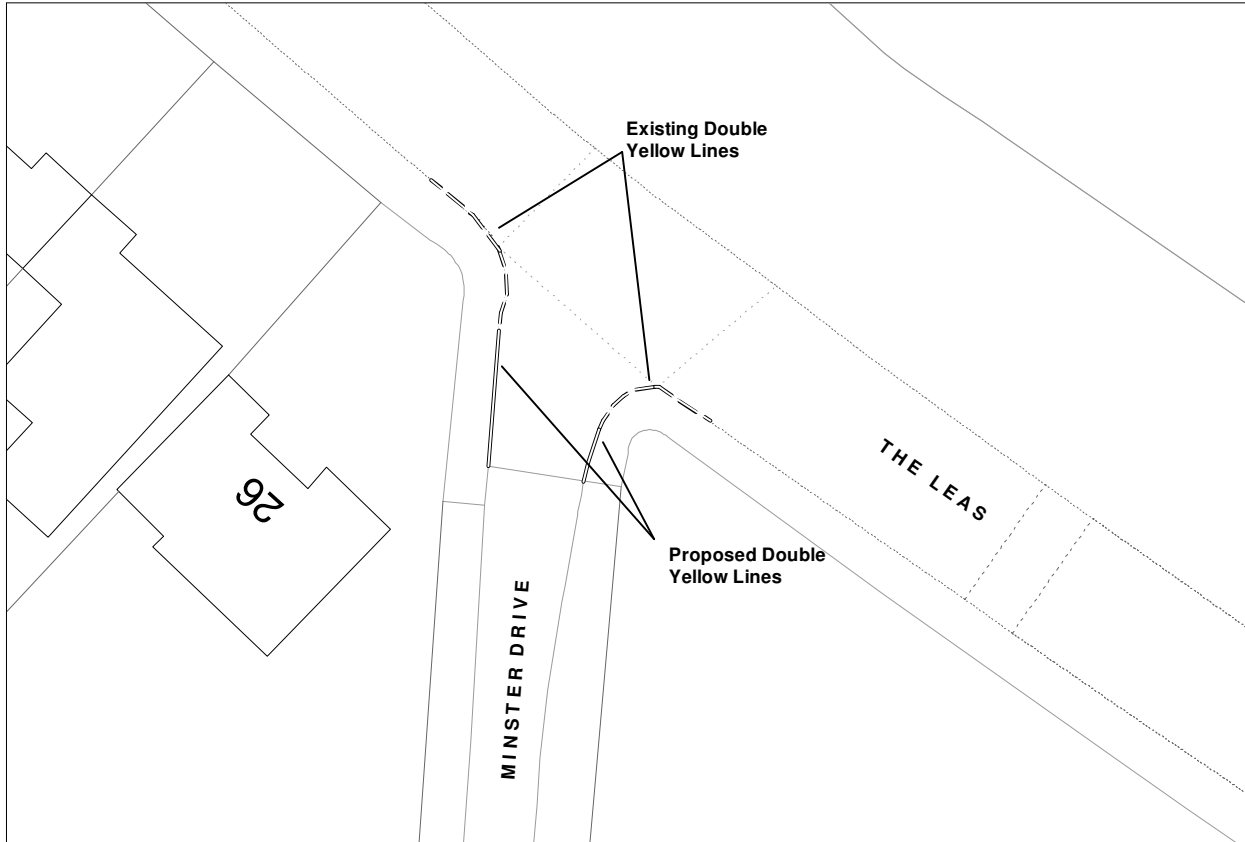

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Proposed Parking Restrictions Murton Place, Graveney

Following a request from a resident, Swale Borough Council are proposing to install waiting restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

The proposals consist of installing a single yellow line on the south side of Murton Place, to restrict parking between 8:30am – 6:30pm Monday to Saturday. By removing parked vehicles from one side of the road, there should be no need for vehicles to park on the footway opposite, thus removing the current pedestrian hazard experienced, particularly during school times.

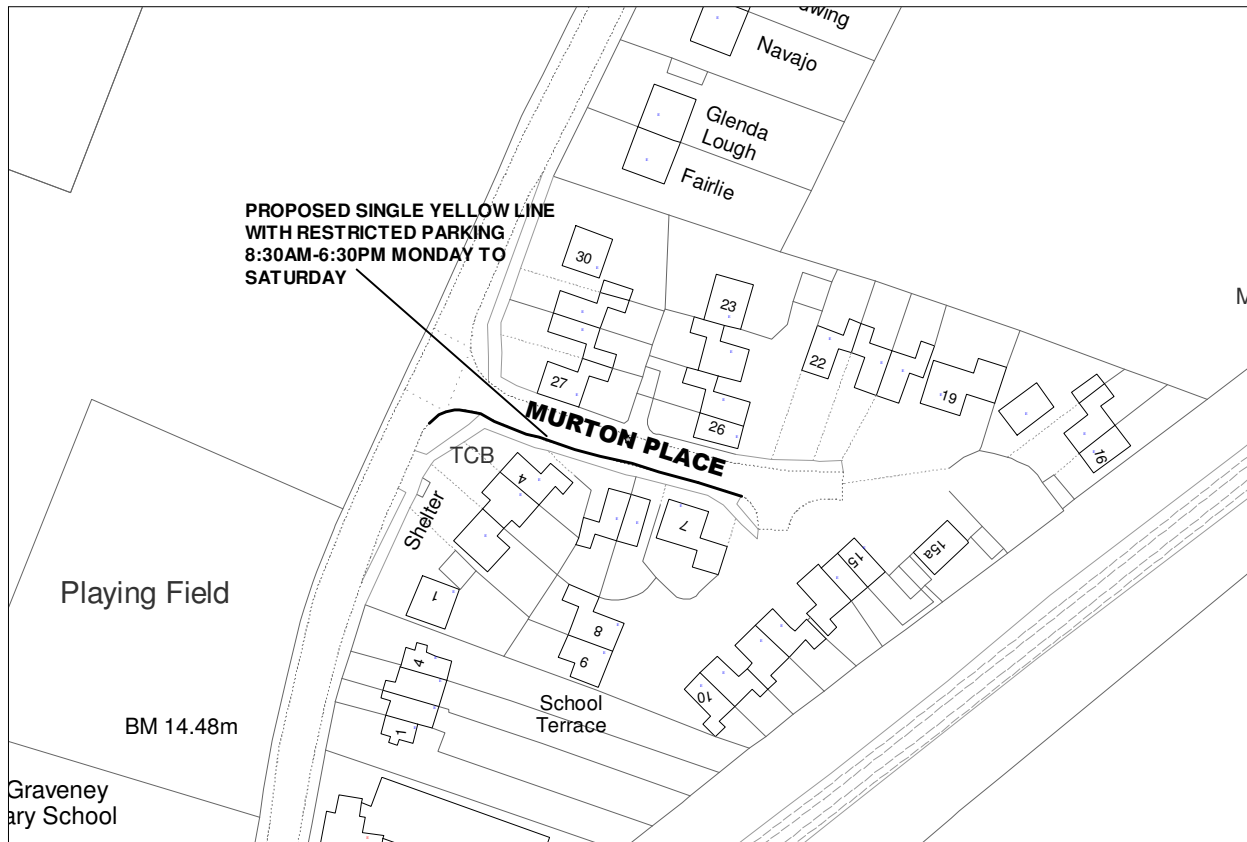

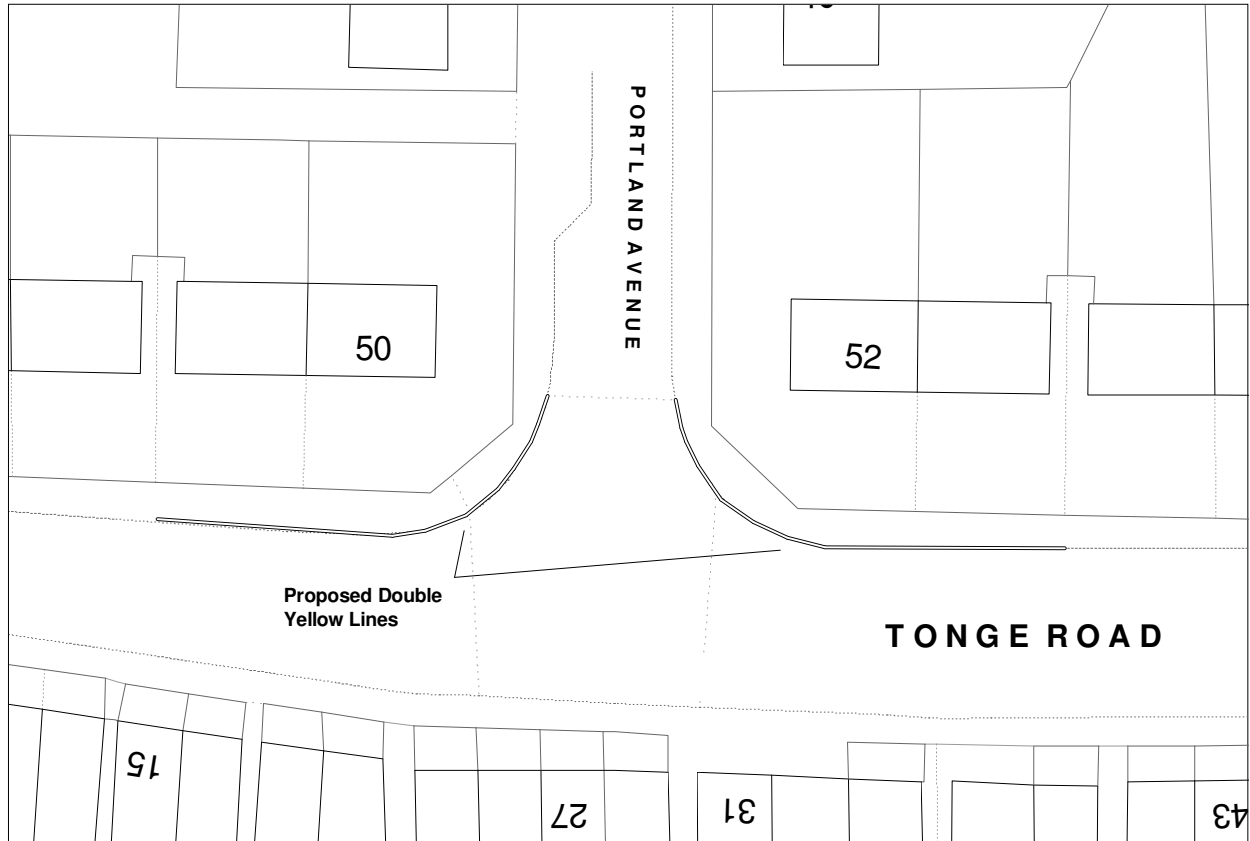

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Proposed Parking Restrictions Wises Lane/Brier Road junction, Sittingbourne

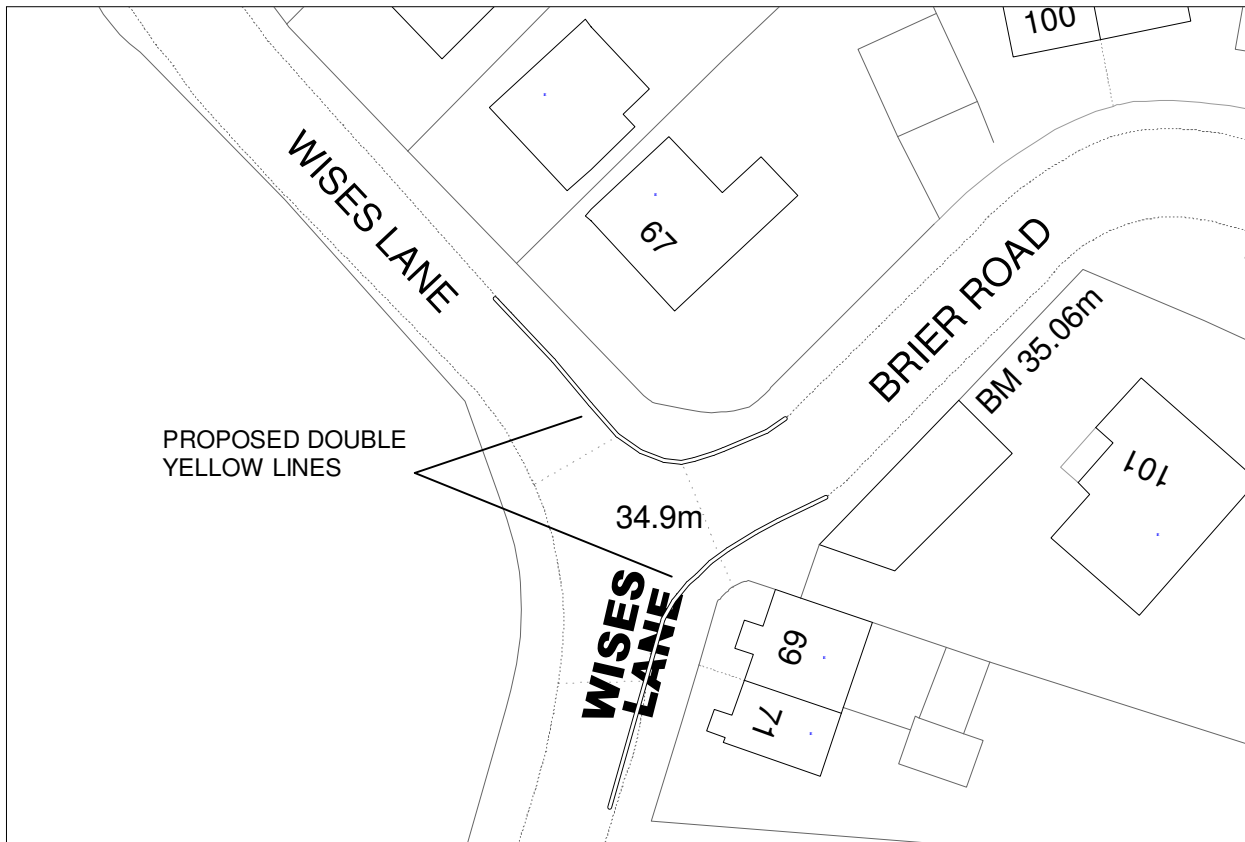

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Proposed Parking Restrictions Wises Lane Area, Sittingbourne

Following a site meeting with representatives from Borden Parish Council, Swale Borough Council is proposing to install waiting restrictions in the Wises Lane area, as shown on the plan overleaf.

The proposals consist of extending the existing double yellow lines into the junctions of Grove Park Avenue and Cherryfields, and opposite the junction of Cherryfields, with the installation of double yellow lines on the northern junction of Brier Road and Wises Lane. It is also proposed to introduce a short section of single yellow line on the east side of Wises Lane, north of Brier Road, with waiting restrictions between 8:00am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday. These timed restrictions are designed to prevent parked vehicles causing sightline obstructions, whilst minimising inconvenience to residents.

It is proposed to introduce these restrictions to improve safety and visibility on the junctions and in Wises Lane, by removing parked vehicles to assist the movement of traffic in the area.

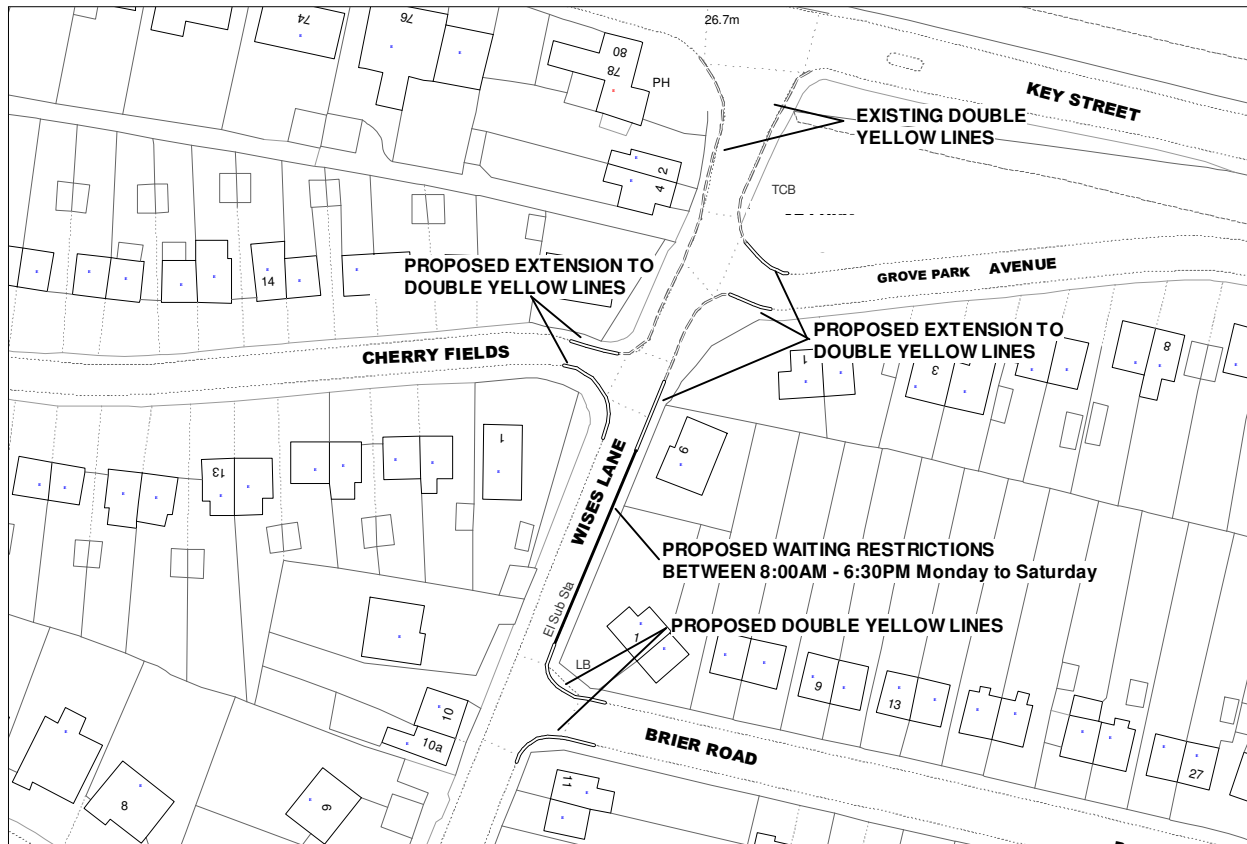
