

### Proposed Amendments to Parking Restrictions Garfield Place, Faversham


Following a request from a local resident, Swale Borough Council are proposing to amend the existing parking restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

# Proposed Parking Restrictions London Road, Teynham


Following a request from a nearby property, Swale Borough Council are proposing to install waiting restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

# **Proposed Parking Restrictions Makenade Avenue, Faversham**


Following a request from a local resident, Swale Borough Council are proposing to install parking restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

### Proposed Amendments to Parking Restrictions Minster Drive/The Leas, Minster


Following a request from a local resident, Swale Borough Council are proposing to amend the existing waiting restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

## Proposed Parking Restrictions Murton Place, Graveney


Following a request from a resident, Swale Borough Council are proposing to install waiting restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.



# Proposed Parking Restrictions Wises Lane/Brier Road junction, Sittingbourne



## **Proposed Parking Restrictions Wises Lane Area, Sittingbourne**

Following a site meeting with representatives from Borden Parish Council, Swale Borough Council is proposing to install waiting restrictions in the Wises Lane area, as shown on the plan overleaf.


The proposals consist of extending the existing double yellow lines into the junctions of Grove Park Avenue and Cherryfields, and opposite the junction of Cherryfields, with the installation of double yellow lines on the northern junction of Brier Road and Wises Lane. It is also proposed to introduce a short section of single yellow line on the east side of Wises Lane, north of Brier Road, with waiting restrictions between 8:00am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday. These timed restrictions are designed to prevent parked vehicles causing sightline obstructions, whilst minimising inconvenience to residents.

It is proposed to introduce these restrictions to improve safety and visibility on the junctions and in Wises Lane, by removing parked vehicles to assist the movement of traffic in the area.
