Introduction

1. Below are details of drainage Improvements to be carried out this financial year by area.

Discussion

Sittingbourne:

Dobbie Close – Install a new gully and piping to existing soakaway in low spot. This will solve flooding problems and also stop silt from building up at the bottom of the drive.

Highstead Road – Install a new drainage system to tie in with existing, due to the profile of the carriageway.

Park Avenue – Install a new gully to resolve flooding to properties.

Borden:

Borden Lane - o/s 167. Install a new gully to resolve flooding to properties.

Wrens Road – rear of bungalows. Clear ditch for a 200m stretch, to resolve flooding to properties. The existing drainage frame work will then be renewed.

Tunstall:

Tunstall Road - o/s Willow House. Clean out drainage system, CCTV line to investigate for possible breaks. Possibility of upgrading the size of the drainage pipes to increase capacity.

Bredgar:

Little Pett Lane – Cleaning and CCTV work to ascertain whether an additional soakaway in field is required to alleviate the problem.

lwade:

School Lane – Install new gully. Carriageway patching works to be incorporated to control the flow of water into the drainage system.

Isle of Sheppey:

Scraps Gate – Install a new gully to resolve flooding to properties.

Conclusion

The drainage team are currently dealing with the backlog of reactive enquiries. However, it is anticipated a programme for the works listed above will be available early in the New Year.
