



Proposed Parking Restrictions Stockers Hill, Boughton-under-Blean Second Consultation

You may recall a previous consultation carried out with residents following a request for double yellow lines along a short section of Stockers Hill.

As a result of comments received from some residents, we have now amended the proposals to a single yellow line on one side of the road, with a double yellow line on the other side of the road. The single yellow line will restrict parking between 10:00am and 11:00am Monday to Friday, to prevent all day commuter parking whilst minimising the impact on residents' parking.

It is proposed to introduce these waiting restrictions to improve the safety of road users by removing parked cars at this location. These vehicles currently force vehicles out to the centre of the carriageway, creating a hazard for oncoming traffic.
