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Sheerness Parking Review
Delamark Road/Royal Road Area



Dear Resident/Occupier

You may recall a questionnaire sent out last year with regard to the Sheerness Parking Review. This was to seek the views of residents and property owners to give us a clearer picture of any problems being experienced with parking within the area.

Regrettably, there was a low response rate to this consultation, and it was therefore agreed that a Residents' Parking Scheme should not be implemented at the present time.

However, with regard to the Delamark Road area of Sheerness, it was suggested that the residents' car parking area between Delamark Road and Broadway could be made into a Pay and Display Car Park, and that a Residents' Parking Scheme could be introduced in Delamark Road. As the introduction of such a scheme in Delamark Road could have an effect on adjoining roads by displacing parked vehicles, it is felt that it would be necessary to consider extending any scheme to include Royal Road.

Obviously the introduction of any Residents' Parking Scheme would only address parking issues during the period of enforcement, in other areas 8:00am-6:00pm Monday-Saturday, and any existing parking problems would continue to exist outside of these restricted times.

The cost of each permit would be £40 a year, and a maximum of 2 permits per household could be issued. Vehicles without permits would be able to park in the parking bays within a scheme for up to 2 hours, no return within 2 hours. Residents would also be able to purchase visitor permits for non-resident single day parking.

I would be most grateful to receive your submitted comments by post before Wednesday 26th August 2009 to allow us to compile all of the responses. **No stamp is required for your response.**
