## <u>Introduction</u>

1. The Local Member for Minster Cliffs requested a review of the speed limit on The Broadway, Minster. The results of the survey undertaken are detailed below.

## **Discussion**

- 2. A 24 hr/7 day automated speed survey commenced on the Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> may 2009 in the vicinity of 95/97 The Broadway. The average weekly mean speed recorded was 34 mph and the 85%tile speed was 39.2 mph. After consultation with the Police they consider that a reduced speed limit to 30 mph would conform to Department of Transport guidance.
- 3. Analysis of the last three year PIC up to June 2006 revealed that there have been 6 slight and 3 serious personal injury crashes. Of these three were considered due to speed.
- 4. The proposal to introduce a lower speed limit was entered into the Scheme Prioritisation System for inclusion in the programme for 2010/11. An initial draft list has identified that the scheme has a very low score and priority ranking.

## **Decision Required**

Those schemes that score few points are deemed 'non virtuous' and cannot be resubmitted for three years unless there is a fundamental change in the scheme proposal, the need for the scheme, or the assessment process.

Kent Highways will continue to monitor the situation through the annual assessment programme.
