<u>Introduction</u>

1. A petition has been received from parents requesting a pedestrian crossing outside the academy as this is now used by children under the age of thirteen.

Discussion

- 2. Any highway improvement has to be submitted for funding through the Council's assessment process. Priority for traffic schemes is normally assessed on whether there is a pattern of personal injury crashes occurring at any particular location and that engineering measures can be devised to try and reduce them.
- 3. Analysis of the last three year Personal Injury Crash database up to June 2009 shows that there have been 3 slight personal injury crashes outside the academy but none involving pedestrians.
- 4. Kent Highways will continue to monitor the situation through their annual assessment programme.
