



## Proposed Amendments to Parking Restrictions Brewery Road, Milton Regis

A request has been received from two local Councillors for amendments to be made to the existing parking restrictions in the vicinity of Milton Court Primary School in Brewery Road, Milton Regis.

To alleviate some of the parking problems experienced during school drop off and collection times, it is proposed to extend the existing School Keep Clear Markings by approximately 9 metres to a point opposite the junction of Cooks Lane. It is also proposed to install double yellow lines on the corners of Cooks Lane and Brewery Road to protect the junction from parked vehicles and improve the sightlines for vehicles.








### PROPOSED SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS - BELLEVUE ROAD, MINSTER

# Proposed Single Yellow Lines Preston Avenue, Faversham

A petition has been received from 13 residents of Preston Avenue in Faversham for Single Yellow Lines to be installed with a one hour parking restriction between 10am and 11am Monday to Friday.

These restrictions have been suggested to tackle commuter parking problems in Preston Avenue by restricting parking for one hour during the day to prevent all day parking, and it is proposed to install these lines on both sides of the road from the junction with the A2 approximately to the boundary of No.26/28 Preston Avenue.


