**Residents Parking Davington Hill Faversham**

There are 7 houses at the lower end of Davington Hill, Faversham close to the junction with Dark Hill. There is just about sufficient space to accommodate parking for the residents of these cottages. However we, the residents, have problems daily with parking.

Because of limited parking near the town centre people are parking both all day and all night in this stretch of Davington Hill. Indeed we have recently had the problem of a car parking in front of the cottages for a full two weeks.

We propose that Swale Borough Council introduces a residents parking scheme in Davington Hill which restricts non resident parking during the day and introduces the permit scheme for residents. We suggest that non residents parking is restricted to one hour with no return for a further hour between 8 am and 9 pm. We would be happy to discuss the detail of this suggestion.

This is a small area which would not create any problems with other streets nearby. It has the support of all those residents of Davington Hill with cars.

We would be grateful if this matter is raised at the appropriate forum within Swale Council and a positive decision reached as soon as possible.
