Plus the elderly lady next door has several nurses every day who park out front. Why not tarmac the grassed area to make it easier for parking most of it is mud and it would not need mowing hence saving money.
6	1		Proposal long overdue as parked vehicles constantly obscure vision on entering The Broadway from Wards Hill or Clovelly Drive. Vehicles parked on either side of The Rise outside my property are likely to cause accidents.
7	1		Perhaps extend yellow lines up Wards Hill Road just past the bus stop. Also speed humps by the water pumping station to slow traffic down entering Scrapsgate Road, there have been accidents.
8		1	Do not need double yellow lines but do need speed restrictions. Also there are carers that attend to the elderly along this stretch of road.
9	1		Elderly neighbours all have carers with cars. It would be a good idea if the other "hill" on Broadway also had same.
10		1	Where will trade persons, carers etc park unless in conjunction with the double yellow lines a couple of 2-3 car parking bays are made by removing sections of the existing grass verge which will deteriorate. Money would be better spent on traffic calming. Double Yellow lines will do nothing to slow people down.

1		1	Traffic exceeds 40 mph - parked vehicles help slow traffic down. Even more vehicles would park on grass verges if unable to park in road. Would support proposal if wooden bollards placed in verges to prevent parking and 30 mph considered.

3	1		Wholeheartedly support double yellow lines providing drivers are not allowed to park on the verges as a consequence causing the continuation of a blocked view downhill.
4	1		Parking on the brow of the hill is extremely dangerous especially with the lack of decent lighting. Double/treble yellow lines should be on all hills along The Broadway.
5	1		Double yellow lines are needed as soon as possible before there is a bad accident. It causes no end of traffic problems.
6		1	It will push vehicles onto the grass verges blocking driveways and parking across paths. Even if you put bollards there, that doesn't keep them off.
7		1	Not required, nothing to warrant double yellow lines, traffic always (in the main) free flowing - and slope to The Rowans just pickup and drop off.
8		1	What you are proposing is unnecessary, there has never been any traffic build up. I do understand if you would do this where the shops are of the whole road.
9	1		Providing that this does not bring an increase of parking on the grass verges which has become very prevalent
10	1		Coming in and out of my driveway without cars parked on the other side will make a life easier.
