

# STATEMENT of REASON



## THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.3A) ORDER 2012

On behalf of Kent County Council, Swale Borough Council is proposing to extend the existing double yellow lines for safety measures at Brenley Lane, Boughton-under-Blean, following a request from Kent Police, and also to introduce double yellow lines for corner protection on the junctions of Bensted Grove/St Nicholas Road, Roebuck Road/St Nicholas Road, Lower Road/Roebuck Road and South Road/Ospringe Road/Lower Road. A short section of double yellow lining is also proposed on both sides of St Nicholas Road near No.50/52 to aid bus movement, and amendments to the existing double yellow lines in Davington Hill to permit Residents' Parking.

The Order also includes amendments to the operating times of the existing Faversham Residents Parking Scheme covering Abbey Street, Abbey Place, Church Street and Vicarage Street from 8.00am-6.30pm to 8.00am-10.00pm Monday to Saturday, and the inclusion of the parking area of Court Street, Faversham into the Residents Parking Scheme, both to tackle parking problems associated with visitors to commercial premises in the area. Also included in the Order are minor amendments to the existing parking bays in Beaumont Terrace to improve vehicle access to private driveways, and additional parking bays in Church Street.

The following roads have been included in the existing Residents' Parking Scheme – Bank Street, Court Street, Cross Lane, Davington Hill, Dorset Place, Forbes Road, Gatefield Lane, Institute Road, Market Place, Market Street, Middle Row, Nelson Gardens, Nelson Street, Nelson Terrace, Partridge Lane, Thomas Road and Water Lane.

It is also proposed to install new parking places for disabled persons vehicles (blue badge holders) in Broomfield Road, Canute Road, Ethelbert Road, and Lees Court Road, Sheldwich, and to revoke certain existing redundant parking places in Abbey Street, Beaumont Terrace, Kingsnorth Road and Saxon Road.

The Order will include some wording changes of an administrative matter which will make no alterations to existing parking and waiting restrictions, and will require no changes to existing parking lines or signs.

## THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.3B) ORDER 2012

On behalf of Kent County Council, Swale Borough Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines for corner protection on the following junctions – Highview Road/Wards Hill Road, Minster and Queenborough Drive/The Broadway, Minster, Church Street/Periwinkle Court, Church Street/Periwinkle Close, Church Street/Watermill Mews Milton Regis, Peregrine Drive/Stanhope Avenue, Tonge Road/Wykeham Road Sittingbourne, School Lane/Ferry Road/The Street and School Lane/School Mews, Iwade. Double yellow lines to improve Highway safety are also proposed on the south side of the school access road, Halfway Road, Halfway, on both sides of The Broadway Minster between Nos. 34-64 and 135-171, near 8-10 Ferry Road, Iwade, on the south side of School Lane Iwade from the Ferry Road junction to No.7 School Lane, on both sides of Portland Avenue Sittingbourne for a distance of 30 metres from Tonge Road, and on both sides of High Street and West Street (to Park Road), Sittingbourne. A short section of double yellow lining is also proposed at the rear of 100 Park Road, in Unity Street Sittingbourne, for improved access to the off-street parking.

Single yellow lines are also proposed for Church Street, Milton Regis outside SRDL factory (with restrictions between 8am-5pm Monday-Friday) and north side of School Lane Iwade between School Mews and Ferry Road (with restrictions between 8.30am-6.30pm Monday-Friday).

New taxi ranks operating between 7pm and 7am are proposed for the lay-bys in Sittingbourne High Street, outside 90-110 and outside St Michael's Church, and a new loading bay in the lay-by outside 90-110 High Street operating between 7am and 7pm.

It is also proposed install new parking places for disabled persons vehicles (blue badge holders) in High Street, Queenborough, Alexandra Road, Berridge Road, Broadway, Coronation Road, Jefferson Road and Medway Road, Sheerness, East Street, Grovehurst Avenue, Oak Road, Park Road, Periwinkle Close, Epps Road, Westerham Road and Whitehall Road, Sittingbourne and to revoke certain existing parking places in Alexandra Road Sheerness, Chalkwell Road and Grovehurst Road Sittingbourne.

The Order will include some wording changes of an administrative matter which will make no alterations to existing parking and waiting restrictions, and will require no changes to existing parking lines or signs
