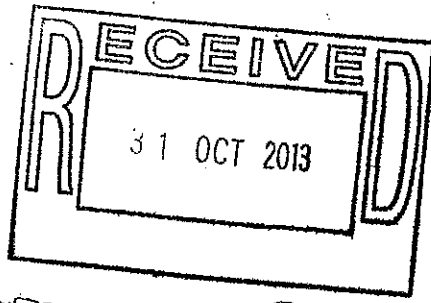

Dear Sirs,

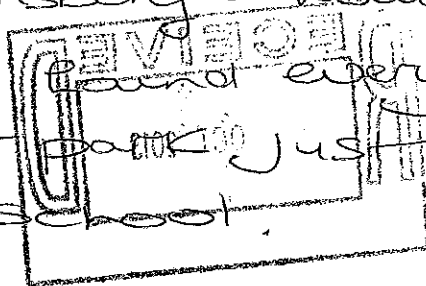
I would like to object to the proposed yellow lines and time restrictions being placed in Capel Road and Whitehall Road in Sittingbourne.

I am sure Sainsbury's would not be happy if they found everybody using their car park just to collect children from school.

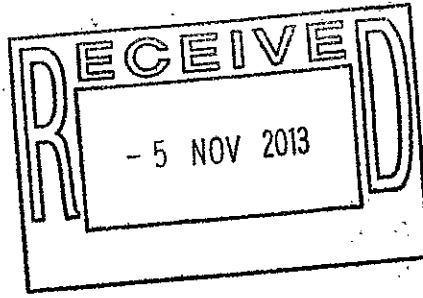


I ask you please to re-consider the option of yellow lines and parking restrictions in Capel Rd + Whitehall Road for the safety of our children.

Dear Sir or Madam,

Formal Objection to Traffic Regulation Order in Capel Road

I am writing to register my objection to the proposed traffic restrictions in Capel Road, Sittingbourne.

My objections are mainly based on the fact that as we have no driveway at our property in which either visitors or tradesmen may park this would cause a major problem on a regular basis. I do not feel it is realistic to tell either of them that they may only visit/work outside of the proposed restricted times.

It is obviously irritating that a number of workers and students at the local schools have taken to using the road as a car park in recent years but as this is basically a quiet cul-de-sac and therefore there is no "through traffic" that is really the extent of the problem, it is an irritant and nothing more.

I feel that the proposed restrictions will also have an adverse effect on the future saleability of our property as an increasing number of households have multiple vehicles and would be put off by having no option of any extra parking area.

In the event of the proposed scheme being implemented I should like to request that the frontage of my property be excluded from the lined area.
