3	1		Welcome the proposal but feel double yellow lines on the north side will increase parking on the south side. Evidence from Lower Road/The Crescent shows this. Suggest double yellow lines on both sides if visibility at the Conyer Road junction is to be improved.

5	1		The car that always parks opposite Selby Court at an angle leaving it very difficult around the corner. The double yellows need to be extended to stop this.
