SUMMARY OF REASONS FOR DECISION	Decision made – REFUSED request to waiver the full amount of grant but amended the amount to be repaid.
	The Council did invest a considerable sum to adapt the applicants existing home and whilst the reasons for moving are understood they feel repayment of part of the grant will not cause financial hardship. The Council therefore feel the repayment conditions should be adhered to but the amount to be repaid is reduced to reflect the time remaining on the existing terms and condition; the amount to be repaid is now set at £3000 The repaid grant will be used to fund future grants to assist additional people in need.
