Representation regarding an application for the on sale of alcohol at:

The Refinery, 122 West Street, Faversham, Kent, ME13 7AA

I am concerned that the extensive hours applied for from Thursday to Sunday present a possibly high level of disturbance for neighbouring residential properties, some above, adjacent and opposite, and, when combined with the customer closing-time traffic from the Bear and the Sun may present a high level of hazard. There is already considerable music disturbance from the Sun and we have suffered some damage from late evening revellers throwing glasses. There are occasional after hours impromptu parties in the car park behind the Sun and we would not welcome additions to this nuisance, in the car park or in West Street and the Market Place. I am also concerned as to the possibility of consumption of alcohol being permitted in West Street where there are already a number of tables set out for the current clients of The Refinery. If the hours were shorter and there were to be no alcohol consumed in the street then I might be prepared to consider it as a feasible proposal.
