It is in fact the condition which refers to 15 EV spaces which is correct. The report at paragraph 8.61 refers to the Council's Parking SPD, which requires for non-residential uses, 10% of spaces to be provided with electric vehicle charging facilities. The development includes 143 parking spaces and therefore 14 spaces would be below the 10% requirement and is rounded up, as per the condition. In error, I've failed to update this in paragraph 8.61.</p>
