**Notes**

1. This drawing shows the general arrangement of the landscape proposals - detailed planting proposals, including species, sizes and numbers to be provided as a planning condition on approval.
2. Planting species to comprise locally appropriate native species around the site perimeter, including oak trees where space permits, and also some field maple, alder and birch. New hedges to be mixed native species, planted as a double staggered row.
3. All planting to take place within the November to March planting season, hedge and tree planting to be into prepared pits backfilled with topsoil, all plants to be protected by individual rabbit guards/ tree shelters. Areas of shrub planting to receive min. 400mm topsoil. Establishment maintenance for five years after planting to include replacement of dead or failed plants.
4. Existing retained trees are to be protected during construction in accordance with BS5837.
