

TABLED UPDATE FOR ITEM 2.4

22/500563/FULL - St Michaels Church, High Street, Sittingbourne, Kent, ME10 4PG

It is proposed that the following heritage condition should be added to the application in the event that it is approved:

‘Prior to the commencement of any demolition or construction/repair works, the applicant shall submit detailed section drawings of the wall to the Local Planning Authority for their prior written approval. The section drawings should include details of the construction / make-up of the existing wall (both where it acts as a retaining wall and a “conventional wall”), the construction of the new wall proposed, and the extent of the reconstruction works (the parts of the structure to be removed), which should be annotated on the drawings.

Reason: To preserve and protect the integrity of the designated heritage asset.’

Other than noting the condition to be added, my recommendation for approval remains unchanged.
