It is the duty of the "responsible person" to make a suitable and sufficient assessment of the risks to which relevant persons are exposed, for the purpose of identifying the general fire precautions needed to comply with the requirements of The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

A competent person should carry out the fire risk assessment. Where any doubt exists, or the assessment identifies areas for concern, it may be appropriate to employ the services of a suitably qualified consultant.

The significant findings of the fire risk assessment must be recorded if:

- · Five or more people are employed; or
- A licence under an enactment is in force; or
- An alterations notice requiring this is in force.

To remain valid, the fire risk assessment will need to be kept under constant review and revised as necessary.

This letter is without prejudice to the powers of the licensing authority and to any requirements or recommendations that may be made by enforcing authorities under other legislation.
