it was with surprise and some horror that I saw the sign regarding the application to extend the license at the above mentioned pub to 1am and 1.30 on Friday and Saturday nights.

We live in close proximity to this pub and the noise from the music is often deafening. To the extent there is no room in our house where we can enjoy open windows.

The appalling behaviour of their clients as they leave the premises has escalated again to the levels not seen since it was the Hole in the Wall some years ago.

The clients are not from houses in the near proximity in the main as they rampage down pavements, through the car park and street, I shouting and swearing on their way home. Also this noise emanates from the garden and becomes unbearable when they play football matches either on the outside tv or with the doors open.

I was surprised that I had not seen this extension posted in the window for the month I believe it has to be in evidence. Behind glass it was also nearly impossible to see. Which is surprising as I walk past so often. It would I think also be important to post to local houses as we are so badly affected by the behaviour.

We have had to recently install CCTV following an incident of drunken vandalism to our property.

There has not been sufficient time to inform all our neighbours of this application and I would request an extension if there is even a consideration of approving this.



It is completely unacceptable to consider ensuring that neighbours would have an increased effect of noise pollution. The noise levels need to he monitored as I have measured extraordinary levels on a Decibel app. This is obviously not a professional one but if you are licensing the premises I would urge that spot checks occur.

None of us can enjoy the use of our gardens.






