

## View 6 Proposed at Yr 1



To achieve the optimum hand-held viewing distance of between 300-500mm (as per The Landscape Institute's guidelines), we recommend printing this image edge to edge on A3 landscape and viewing it from a distance of 370mm. Panoramic images should be viewed on a curved surface so that peripheral parts of the image are viewed at the same intended viewing distance or viewed by panning across a flat image with the eye remaining at the recommended viewing distance.
