## Proposed Removal of Bollards James Street, Sheerness

You may be aware of issues with the refuse freighter gaining access along James Street in Sheerness, resulting in delays in emptying household waste bins. We are therefore looking into the possibility of removing the concrete bollards along the road to allow vehicles to park slightly closer to the houses, providing a wider access along the road.

We would be most grateful to receive your views as to whether you support or object to the proposed removal of the bollards, and the responses received will be reported to the Swale Joint Transportation Board to consider at their next meeting. Please note that direct, individual responses will not be sent out in response to each questionnaire.
