Proposed Extension to Double Yellow Lines Attlee Way, Sittingbourne

Following a request from the Local Councillor, proposals have been drafted to extend the existing double yellow lines on the north side of Attlee Way Sittingbourne, from the existing lines near Satis Avenue to the west of the Foxgrove junction. The proposals, to be funded through the County Members' Highway Grant, have been requested to assist vehicle movements and improve sightlines for vehicles turning into Attlee Way. Details of the proposals can be found on the plan overleaf.

We would be most grateful to receive your views as to whether you support or object to the proposals, and the responses received will be reported to the Swale Joint Transportation Board to consider at their next meeting.
