**Response:** I reported a break even position at the beginning of the year. (2017). By the end of the financial year, Swale CCG were reporting a £2m deficit but stated no adverse effect on Swale residents. To date the CCG are forecasting a £6m risk of which they are attempting to mitigate £5m of the risk the remaining £1m they will cover through reduced medicine costs and efficiency savings. They are working towards a break-even position at financial year end April 2018, again with no impact on local patient care.
